



The main physical features of the EXP50 color-screen expansion module are color LCD screen, Ext keys, LED indicators, USB jack, Mini USB jack and power interface.



The main physical features of the EXP50 color-screen expansion module are described as below:

1	Ext Keys	Assign various features to these keys.
2	LED Indicators	Indicate the Ext key status. For more information, refer to LED Instructions on page 8.
3	Color LCD Screen	Shows key feature label and key feature icon. For more information, refer to Icon Instructions on page 4.
4	Page Keys	Press these keys to navigate to corresponding page to view additional keys.
5	USB Jack	<ul> <li>Connects the supplied cable to the Mini USB jack on the next expansion module.</li> <li>Connects the Wi-Fi USB dongle WF40, USB headset or USB flash drive.</li> </ul>
6	Mini Jack	Connects the supplied cable to the USB jack on the host phone or to the USB jack on the prior expansion module.
7	Power Interface	Connects a power adapter to the expansion module. When more than two expansion modules are connected to a single host phone, you need to connect a power adapter to any one of the expansion modules.

Ext key LED (configured as a Forward key with a value (destination number))

LED Status	Description
Solid green	The always forward feature is activated.

Note

If the value (the destination number) is not configured for a Forward key, the key LED will solid green when the always/busy/no answer forward feature is activated. It is off when the always/busy/no answer forward feature is deactivated.

**Ext key LED** (configured as a BLF key)

Solid green	The monitored user is idle.
Fast-flashing red	The monitored user receives an incoming call.

## **Installation**

The EXP50 color-screen expansion module applies to Yealink T52S/T54S/T56A/T58A/T58V media IP phones. To easily connect the EXP50 to the phone, please unplug the phone stand from the IP phone.

Note

Up to three expansion modules can be connected to a media IP phone.

#### To unplug the stand from the IP phone:


- **1.** Unplug the power adapter and Ethernet cable from the IP phone.
- 2. Unplug the handset attached to the IP phone.
- 3. Turn the IP phone over and lay it on a non-slip, flat surface.
- 4. Unplug the stand from the IP phone.

#### To connect the EXP50 color-screen expansion module:


- **1.** Turn over the phone and expansion module, and lay them on a flat, non-flat, non-slip surface.
- 2. (Optional.) The slots of IP phone may be plugged up by silica gel. You can pull out the silica

gel.


**3.** Connect the EXP50 color-screen expansion module and the IP phone using the supplied connecting sheet and screw.




If you want to connect two or more expansion modules, pull out the silica gel and connect two expansion modules as below.




Connecting two expansion modules on a single host phone is shown as below:



**4.** Connect the USB jack on the host phone and the mini USB jack on the expansion module using one supplied cable.





If you connect two expansion modules, connect the USB jack on the prior expansion module and the mini USB jack on the next expansion module using another supplied cable. Connecting two expansion modules on a single host phone is shown as below:

Note

Power is automatically transferred from the host phone to the expansion module(s) upon connection. If you want to use more than one expansion modules on a single phone, you need to connect an additional Yealink power adapter (5V/2A) to any one of the expansion modules.



## Startup

After the EXP50 color-screen expansion module is powered on, the LCD screen of the EXP50 color-screen expansion module will display "Welcome Loading...Please wait".



After a short time, the loading screen will disappear, and then you can assign the desired feature to the EXP50 color-screen expansion module.

# Customizing the Yealink EXP50 Color-screen Expansion Module

You can customize EXP50 color-screen expansion module by personally configuring certain settings.

This chapter provides basic operating instructions for customizing EXP50 color-screen expansion module. Topics include:

- Wallpaper
- Screen Saver
- Power Saving
- Adjusting the Backlight

## Wallpaper

You can customize the wallpaper expansion module EXP50 when connected to the media IP phone. The wallpaper can be changed via host phone user interface or web user interface. You can use a picture that is stored on your USB flash drives as wallpaper on your phone. When you set one of your pictures as the wallpaper, the picture will display on the wallpaper list. You can only upload custom pictures as wallpaper images via web user interface.

## **Uploading the Custom Pictures**

The color-screen expansion module EXP50 supports the file format of pictures in the following table:

#### 3. Click **Upload** to upload the file.

The uploaded custom picture will apply to media IP phone and expansion module EXP50, and appears in the pull-down lists of **Wallpaper** and **Wallpaper for expansion modules** synchronously.

## **Deleting the Custom Pictures**

You can delete the custom wallpaper via phone user interface or via web user interface.

#### To delete the custom picture via phone user interface:

- 1. Press Menu->Basic->Display->EXP Wallpaper.
- 2. Press ( $\bullet$ ) or ( $\bullet$ ), or the **Switch** soft key to select the desired picture.

- Press the **Delete** soft key to delete the corresponding picture.
   The LCD screen prompts "Delete selected images?".
- 4. Press the **OK** soft key to accept the change.

You can also delete the custom wallpaper by clicking **Del** when selecting the desired custom wallpaper in the **Wallpaper** or **Wallpaper for expansion modules** field. As shown below:

The custom wallpaper will disappear from the pull-down lists of **Wallpaper** and **Wallpaper for** expansion modules synchronously.

## **Changing the Wallpaper**

You can change the wallpaper via phone user interface or web user interface.

To change the EXP wallpaper via phone user interface:

- 1. Press Menu->Basic->Display->EXP Wallpaper.
- 2. Press  $(\cdot)$  or  $(\cdot)$  , or the **Switch** soft key to select the desired wallpaper image.

3. Press the Save soft key to accept the change or the Back soft key to cancel.

If the wallpaper from the USB flash drive has been uploaded, you can change the desired wallpaper directly. Or you can set the custom wallpaper from the USB flash drive directly.

#### To add the custom picture from a USB flash drive via phone user interface:

- 1. Press Menu->Record->Browse Photo.
- 2. Press  $(\cdot)$  or  $(\cdot)$ , or the **Switch** soft key to select the desired picture.
- 3. Press the **Preview** soft key.
- 4. Press the Set as soft key, and then select Set as EXP wallpaper.

5. Press the **OK** soft key to accept the change.

The EXP wallpaper will change to the corresponding picture.

**Note** Before uploading the custom picture from the USB flash drive, please make sure that the USB flash drive has been connected to expansion module EXP50 successfully, and the picture is stored in the root folder on the USB flash drive and not stored in a specific folder.

Wallpaper for expansion modules is configurable via web user interface at the path

#### Settings->Preference.

**Note** The EXP50 color-screen expansion module screen size is 4.3 inches (Resolution: 272x480). If the size of the custom wallpaper doesn't meet the IP phone screen size, the wallpaper will be stretched or zoomed out according to the screen size.

For more information on wallpaper, refer to the *Wallpaper* section of *Yealink phone-specific user guide*.

## Screen Saver

The screen saver will automatically start when the IP phone is idle for the preset waiting time. The screen saver is used to blank the screen or fill it with moving images or patterns. If you connect a color-screen expansion module EXP50 to the IP phone, the screensaver will start or stop on the phone and EXP50 synchronously.

#### The screen saver will be stopped if one of the following phone events occurs:

- Press any key.
- Pick up/hang up the handset.
- There is an incoming call.
- A new prompt (e.g., missed call, new voice mail or forwarded call).
- The status of BLF key changes.

If your phone and EXP50 is idle again for a specified period of time, the screen saver will start again. The time & date and certain feature status icons (e.g., a new text message, auto answer, DND) will also display on the screen saver. For more information on the icons, refer to Icon Instructions on page 4. You can configure the phone whether to display the time & date on the screen saver or not.

You can configure the screen saver of SIP-T54S media IP phone, and upload custom pictures to set up a screen saver of your picture via web user interface. You can configure the screen saver wait time, screen saver type and screen saver display clock via phone user interface or web user interface.

- 2. Select Custom from the pull-down list of Screensaver Type.
- **3.** In the **Upload Screensaver** field, click **Browse** to locate the custom picture from your local system, and then click **Upload**.

The custom picture appears in **Screensaver** list. You can only delete the custom picture by clicking **Del** when the desired custom picture is selected in the **Screensaver** field.

#### To upload a custom picture from USB flash drive via phone user interface:

- 1. Press Menu->USB Record->Browse Photo.
- 2. Press  $(\bar{\ })$  or  $(\bar{\ })$  , or the **Switch** soft key to select the desired picture.
- 3. Press the **Preview** soft key.
- 4. Press the Set as soft key, and then select Set as screensaver.

## **Power Saving**

The power saving feature is used to turn off the backlight and screen to conserve energy. The EXP50 color-screen expansion module enters power-saving mode after it has been idle for a certain period of time. The power LED illuminates solid red for 1000ms and goes out for 3000ms alternately.

The EXP50 color-screen expansion module will exit power-saving mode if one of the following phone events occurs:

- Press any key on the host phone or EXP50.
- Pick up/hang up the handset on the host phone.

- There is an incoming call.
- A new prompt (e.g., missed call, new voice mail or forwarded call) on the host phone.
- The status of BLF key changes.

You can configure the following power-saving settings:

- Office Hour
- Idle Timeout (minutes)

The office hour and idle timeout (minutes) settings work only if the power saving feature is enabled.

**Note** Power saving is configurable via web user interface only.

## **Configuring the Idle Timeout**

Idle Timeout specifies the period of time before the IP phone enters power-saving mode. The following three types of idle timeout you can configure:

- Office Hours Idle TimeOut: Configures the idle timeout for office hours.
- Off Hours Idle TimeOut: Configures the idle timeout for non-office hours.
- User Input Extension Idle TimeOut: Configures idle timeout that applies after you use the IP phone (for example, press a key on the phone or pick up/hang up the handset).

By default, the Office Hours Idle TimeOut is much longer than the Off Hours Idle TimeOut. Call recording allows users to record calls. Normally, there are 2 main methods to trigger a recording on a certain server. We call them record and URL record. Record is for the phone to send the server a SIP INFO message containing a specific header. URL record is for the phone to send an HTTP URL to the server. The server processes these messages and decides to start or stop a recording.

You can configure an Ext key as the record key. Then you can record calls using the record method by pressing the record key. For more information on URL record, refer to URL Record on page 50.

### To configure an Ext key as the record key:

- 1. Click on Dsskey->Ext Key.
- 2. In the desired Ext key field, select **Record** from the pull-down list of **Type**.
- 3. Enter the desired value in the Label field or leave it blank.

### To configure an Ext key as the multicast paging key:

- 1. Click on Dsskey->Ext Key.
- 2. In the desired Ext key field, select Paging from the pull-down list of Type.
- Enter the multicast IP address and port number in the Value field (e.g., 224.5.6.20:10008).
   The valid multicast IP addresses range from 224.0.0.0 to 239.255.255.255.
- 4. Enter the desired value in the Label field or leave it blank.

If you leave this field blank, the LCD screen of the EXP50 color-screen expansion module will display "the value specified in the Value field" (e.g., 224.5.6.20:10008).

- 3. Enter the desired value in the Label field or leave it blank.

To use the ACD feature, you should configure an Ext key as the ACD key in advance. You can press the ACD key to log in the ACD system.

### To configure an Ext key as the ACD key:

- 1. Click on Dsskey->Ext Key.
- 2. In the desired Ext key field, select ACD from the pull-down list of Type.
- 3. Enter the desired value in the Label field.

# Using the Yealink EXP50 Color-screen Expansion Module

# **Using the Line Key**

You can configure line keys to associate with a line for the connected EXP50 color-screen expansion module. Incoming calls to the line can be distributed evenly among the available line keys both on the host phone and the connected EXP50 color-screen expansion module. Each line key on the connected EXP50 color-screen expansion module can only handle one call. For more information on configuring an Ext key as the line key, refer to Line on page 26.

You can use a line key to do the following:

- Placing a call
- Answering a call
- Placing an active call on hold
- Resuming a held call

#### To place a call using the line key:

- **1.** Press the line key on the EXP50 color-screen expansion module, the host phone will enter the pre-dialing screen.
- 2. Enter the desired number using the keypad on the host phone.
- 3. Press  $\begin{pmatrix} a_k \end{pmatrix}$ ,  $\| \boldsymbol{\#}_{ak} \|$  or the **Send** soft key on the host phone.

For more information on placing a call, refer to the *Placing Calls* section of *Yealink phone-specific user guide*.

#### To answer a call using the line key:

- **1.** Press the line key with the fast-flashing green LED indicator on the EXP50 color-screen expansion module.
- **Note** The line configured on the phone takes precedence over that configured on the color-screen expansion module. Only if the line configured on the phone is being used, the LED indicator of the line key corresponding to this line on the color-screen expansion module will fast flash green when this line receives a new incoming call.

#### To place an active call on hold using the line key:

1. Press the line key corresponding to line with the active call you want to place on hold.

#### To resume a held call using the line key:

1. Press the line key corresponding to line with the held call you want to resume.

You can also view the line status through LED indicators. For more information on line key LED indications, refer to LED Instructions on page 8.

### **Using the Busy Lamp Field**

The busy lamp field (BLF) feature allows you to monitor the status change of users through BLF LED indicators. For example, you can configure a BLF key on the connected EXP50 color-screen expansion module to monitor the status of a friend's line (busy or idle). For more information on configuring an Ext key as the BLF key, refer to Busy Lamp Field (BLF) on page 28.

The BLF key LED illuminates solid red when the monitored line is in use. The BLF key LED illuminates solid green when the monitored line is idle. For more information on BLF key LED indications, refer to LED Instructions on page 8.

You can press a BLF key to dial out the monitored phone number when the monitored line is idle and pick up calls that are received on the monitored line. When there is an active call on the host phone, you can transfer the active call to the monitored phone number directly by pressing the BLF key.

For more information on using BLF feature on the phone, refer to the *Busy Lamp Field (BLF)* section of *Yealink phone-specific user guide*.

# Resetting the Yealink EXP50 Color-screen Expansion Module

You can reset the EXP50 color-screen expansion module to clear all configurations by resetting the host phone. The reset process of the EXP50 color-screen expansion module is synchronized with the host phone.

#### To reset the EXP50 color-screen expansion module via phone user interface:

- Press Menu->Advanced (password: admin) ->Reset Config->Reset to Factory on the host phone.
- 2. Press the **Reset** soft key on the host phone.

The LCD screen of the host phone prompts "Welcom Initializing...Please wait".



The host phone and the EXP50 color-screen expansion module will be reset to factory settings successfully after startup.

**Note** Reset of the EXP50 color-screen expansion module can lead to resetting the host phone. And then all custom settings on the host phone and the EXP50 color-screen expansion module will be overwritten after resetting.
